## Update on field trips within walking distance

The CBE values the educational benefit of field trips. Field trips close to our school can complement classroom learning by giving students opportunities to explore the community around their school.

Please be advised the process for trips within walking distance of the school has been simplified, excluding restricted activities, e.g. swimming. As parents/guardians, you will no longer need to fill out a consent form for your child to go on a class trip that is walking distance from the school, e.g. to a local park. Appropriate walking distance is determined by the Principal and may vary, depending on the age of the students.

Teachers will provide at least 48 hours notice when planning a trip to a local site. You will be reminded about these trips by notice on our website or blog, note or email. Our first walking trip is on Monday, Oct. 29. It will be to the community library as part of our participation in the program, It's A Crime Not To Read. (A partnership with Calgary Police Association and The Calgary Board of Education.) We are planning to walk, leaving the school at 1:00 and returning by 2:45 in time for dismissal.

If you would like to volunteer and have a current Police Background Check, please let the school know.
